### 教學省思

在這次交通安全的主題教學,我們在搜集資訊時了解世界先進各國對行人的尊重,以及行人也要遵守的交通禮儀。透過英語主題教學,除了建立學生在實際生活裡 英語語用的能力,也讓學生了解本單元欲傳達的交通禮儀概念,促進國際文化理解。

有很多人懷疑交通安全運用在英語教學,是不是會太難。在實際運作時,只要老師不斷帶學生朗誦相關主題用語,如:Raise your hands when crossing the road,讓學生不斷重複語音,了解其義,進而達到語用的目的;同時,實際的表演方式,讓學生根據對話內容的情境和情緒,用肢體和聲調表現文中的劇情,加深交通安全對話的印象。老師適時給予安全議題上的引導,讓學生從做中學,不僅能習得安全議題的相關知識,更可延伸自我英語學習觸角,也親身體驗「Raise your hands when crossing the road 舉手過馬路,安全跟著走」的教學設計目標。


本自編教材對於國中八年級學生來說算中偏難,十個單字也算是高中範圍,不太會是國中生平常會認識或背到的字。克服困難的方法是實地教學前,將課文與單字發下去做為學生回家閱讀作業,所以在上課時,學生唸得算順,就有利下一步學生實地以英語演練交通禮儀的情境對話。配合圖片、海報展示,以及手邊取材當作車子方向盤和斑馬線情境演出,也能讓同學再更了解情境一些。

在編寫這教案過程當中,我們覺得英語教學可以和許多議題結合,取自生活議題,豐富英語教學內容與應用機會。雖然在編寫教案、對話、單字,過程花了許多時間與討論;在實地演練時,我們漸漸感受到,學生可以應用英語,可以透過我們編的教材瞭解世界先進各國的交通安全禮儀,我們也以世界公民自我期待,讓孩子透過親身演練,深深牢記「Raise your hands when crossing the road 舉手過馬路,安全跟著走」,養成習慣,應用於日常生活中。

# **Raise Your Hands When Crossing the Road**

# • Vocabulary

	Words	<u>Definition</u>
1.	pedestrian	a person who is walking, esp. in an area where vehicles go
2.	vehicle	something used to transport people or goods, esp. something used on land or roads
3.	crosswalk	(also called pedestrian crossing) a marked place in a street where traffic must stop to allow people to walk across
4.	crossroad	a place where two roads meet and cross each other
5.	overpass	a bridge that carries a road or railroad over another road
6.	shortcut	a route that is more direct than the usual route, or a quicker way of doing something
7.	priority	something that is considered more important than other matters
8.	principle	a moral rule or standard of good behavior or fair dealing
9.	regard	greetings and expressions of affection
10.	courtesy	polite behavior, or a polite action
