■ 問題的形式：

1. **Yes / No questions:** 回答時用 Yes / No

1-1. be 動詞提出來的問題：

例： Q: Are you a student?

A: Yes, I am. / No, I am a nurse.

1-2. 助動詞提出來的問題：

功能性的助動詞：Do, Does, Did / Have, Has, Had

情態助動詞：Can, May, Will, Should...

例 1: Q: Do you like swimming?

A: Yes, I do. / No, I don't.

例 2: Q: Can you come this afternoon?

A: Yes. See you then. / No, I can't. (or "I'm sorry.") I have a date then.


2. **Wh-questions:** 用 6 W 問的問題：

Who, What, When, Where, Why, How，等疑問詞。

根據閱讀文章的事實回答，有時需要整合思考推理回答。

■ 問題的層次：設問分成 local 和 global 兩類

1. Local：針對文章內容出現的細節（detail）、事實（fact）而設問。
2. Global：根據閱讀文章的事實整合、思考、推理而回答。答案可能不見得在文章文字裡，而是要讀出弦外之音（read between the lines）。

After she thanked him and saw him drive away, she got into the car and drove it back into the garden, where she got out with the children, and went back to her work in the house again--with clean hands.

2. What was the woman's purpose (目的)?
