

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配合課本句型學習 : 比較級、最高級

第一節 Who's Best 句型練習與預測

- 1. 課前掃瞄書中部分圖片,變成簡報檔
- 2. 動機引導:利用英語歌曲 Torn Between Two Lovers 引起學生興趣 (p.1-2 可印雙面對切)
- 3. 介紹書中人物,猜測哪些人陷入三角戀情。
- 4. 利用課本正在學的比較級,預測兩個男主角的特質。(p.2)
- 5. 辨識形容詞:看 summary,用螢光筆把形容詞標示出來,並用比較級比較兩位男主角。(p.3)

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6. 利用老師提供的單字,加以猜測兩個男主角的特質,並預測故事結局。(p.4)

第二節 Who's Best / Boys vs. Girls 閱讀與速讀

- 1. 發下學習單 p.5-6
- 2. 發下 Who's Best,利用網路計時器,以秒為單位,請學生速讀,並記錄閱讀時間。(p.5)
- 3. 討論 Who's Best 的內容。
- 4. 發下 Boys vs. Girls,不做任何預測與討論,直接速讀本書,並記錄閱讀時間。(p.5)
- 5. 計算閱讀兩本書的平均閱讀速度。看看讀第二本時有沒有進步。 計算方式:字數 ÷ 秒數 × 60 = 每分鐘閱讀速度
- 6. 討論 Boys vs. Girlst 的內容。
- 7. 複習重要的句型,在兩本書中找出例句。若該書沒有該句型則打 X。(p.5-6)

第三節 寫作:Compare and Contrast

- 1. 發下學習單 p.7-8
- 2. 練習比較與對比--範例引導: Uma and Whoopie
- 3. 練習比較與對比--寫作引導: The weather in summer and in winter
- 4. 寫作組織:It's Your Turn (p.8)
- 5. 把 p. 8 的組織謄寫到 p.9 後,處理連貫,一週後繳交。如果有能力直接寫,可省略 p.8 步驟。

參考:閱讀速度

- 1. 閱讀速度與閱讀理解息息相關,相互影響。
- 2. 依國外文獻,測試閱讀速度結果如下:
 - 一般速度:250-300 字 / 分鐘
 - 能力弱者:30-100 字 / 分鐘
 - 100 字/分鐘 以上就算是速度快的閱讀者。
 - 國際上認定平均速度是 250 字 / 分鐘。
 - 但可依閱讀難度與學生狀況彈性調整。
- 3. 以我個人帶學生的經驗,以基測閱讀題材的難度檢核:
 - 學生能保持 200 字/分鐘以上,基測應試作答才可游刃有餘。
 - 學生低於 100 字/分鐘,不但作答時間不足,更影響閱讀理解,答對率也相對較低。
- 4. 如果學生閱讀速度慢,答對率低,應從基礎的閱讀策略訓練起:
 - 基礎期:國小的字母拼讀 (phonics) 與常用字 (sight words) 訓練
 - 準備期:短文閱讀,漸漸脫離教科書主題
 - 閱讀策略指導:預測、略讀、跳讀、上下文猜字義、訊息整理、圖解組織。
