Dan Brown, the writer of the Da Vinci Code, is one of the top **<u>novelists</u>** in the world, and millions of people all over the world enjoy his stories.

He was the oldest of three children in his family. His mother was a musician, playing the music in a church. His father was a math teacher, writing <u>textbooks</u> and teaching high school math. Dan grew up in such a family full of <u>religion</u> and science, so he became interested in

codes and keys. **These** all formed the ideas in the stories to lead the readers into the wonderful guessing games.

After he finished his study in the university, he spent time as an English teacher before turning to be a full-time writer. In 1996, his interest in code-breaking led him to write his first novel, Digital Fortress, and it soon became the most popular eBook in the US. The following two novels had little success, but the fourth novel, The Da Vinci Code, sold best, going to the top of the New York Times Best Seller list during its first week of **release** in 2003. Its success helped push his earlier books to sell. In 2004, all of his four novels were on the New York Times best-seller list in the same week. In 2005, he made Time magazine's list of the 100 most important people of the year. The Times reported that he made \$250 million from "Da Vinci Code" sales. The Da Vinci Code is now one of the most popular books of all time, with 70 million copies **worldwide** till 2006.
