Mickey Mouse is a very famous cartoon character in the world, but the real mouse is not as cute and healthy as Mickey Mouse. Some kind of mice can make people sick. To keep health, you have to know more about them.

Mostly, mice are active at night. They have poor eyes, so they smell, taste, touch, and hear more than see. Their hairs help them go around in the dark. They also have an excellent sense of balance, so they can walk along telephone wires, ropes and other thin things.

It is easy for house mice to produce baby mice. They can quickly have a **nest** of baby in a week. There are usually about 6 mice in a nest, and a mother mouse may produce ten nests in a year. A young mouse takes 35 days to grow up and be able to produce baby mice, so it is difficult for them to die out in the world.

They sometimes bring terrible sickness to people. If we get the sickness from them, we might have a fever like a cold and sometimes die of the sickness. We have to keep our environment clean. Do not put every thing in a mess in the house because mice like to build their nests and save food in a messy place.
