(b) The Empire State Building

The Empire State Building in New York was the first building to have over 100 floors and was the tallest building in the world from 1931 until 1972.



(c) Taipei 101

Taipei 101, with 101 floors in it, was the tallest building in the world from 2004 to 2010. It looks like a large tower. Because of it, Taiwan became famous to the world.



(d) The Petronas Towers

The Petronas Towers in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, were the tallest buildings in the world from 1998 to 2004 until Taipei 101 **surpassed** it, but it is still the world's tallest twin buildings.

(e) The original World Trade Center

The original World Trade Center had seven office buildings in total. The original 1 World Trade Center (the North Tower) and 2 World Trade Center (the South Tower), were together as the Twin Towers. They were the tallest buildings in the world before The Petronas Towers <u>surpassed</u> it. The Center opened in 1973, but the Twin Towers fell during the September 11 attacks in 2001.


